Casual attire, long pants, shorts, ball cap (sun protection), socks and a light jacket.

Sturdy sole shoes for walking, hiking and climbing outdoor activities (vs. flip flops)

Sleeping bags as there is no bedding provided. Also, bring your favorite pillow.

No more than \$100.00 cash.

Disposable camera.

Digital or printed photographs of your family, friends, and your country that you would like to share with the other campers and our Lion Club members.

Also we would like to know the size of your Tee shirt that you wear as one will be provided to you.

Please Do Not Bring:

Expensive electronic cameras, devices and jewelry e.g. I Pods, video games, watches, cell phones (no cell coverage). If brought – they must be turned over to the Camp Director and they will return them to you once the camp is completed.

Absolutely NO smoking, drugs or alcohol. Violation of this rule will result in the youth being expelled from the Camp.
